- 12 again facing first corners.
- 13 First couple turn first corner by the right hand to finish each facing partner's second corner (first
- 16 corners dance 4 steps).
- 17 First couple dance a half reel of four with second corners to finish again facing partner's second
- 20 corner
- 21 First couple turn partner's second corner by the right hand to finish back to back in the centre of the
- 24 dance, first woman facing down, first man facing up.
- 25 First woman with second couple and first man with third couple dance three hands round, first
- woman / second man and first man / third woman releasing hands on bar 28.
- 29 First woman joining hands with third woman and first man joining hands with second man, third
- 32 first and second couples dance six hands round half way to own sides.

Repeat from second place.
