A 32 bar reel for three couples in a four-couple longwise set

$1 - 4 \\ 4 - 8$	1^{st} couple set and cross over, giving right hands 1^{st} and 2^{nd} couples dance four hands once round to the left
9 – 12 13 – 16	1^{st} couple set and cast off one place, 2^{nd} couple step up on bars 11-12 1^{st} couple dance a half figure of eight round 3^{rd} couple
17 – 24	1^{st} couple lead down the middle and up; 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} couples stepping in on last bar
25 - 32	2 nd , 1 st and 3 rd couples dance a promenade.

The music for this dance was composed by John Barnes and the dance devised by Helen Beaney in celebration of the 70th birthday of Hazel Convery of the Dublin Scottish Country Dance Club.
