## a jig in 32 bars for 3 couples in a longwise set

recommended tune: Set of Jigs from Diamond Jubilee by DAVID HALL and THE MANCHESTER SCOTTISH DANCE BAND

1-2 1st couple set to each other

3-4 First couple, giving right hands, turn three quarters.

5-8 First lady casts off round second woman's place and dances across to second man's place, finish facing out, while first man, following his partner, dances across and casts off to second place on woman's side. Second couple step up on bars 7 and 8.

9-12 First lady, with second and third man, dances a half reel of three on the sideline, starting left shoulder to third man, while first man, with second and third lady, dances a half reel of three on the sideline, starting left shoulder to third lady.

13-16 First lady casts up round third man (first man's place) and dances down to end between second couple, while first man, following his partner, dances across and casts up to finish between third couple, both finish facing the bottom.

17-20 First lady, with second couple, dance a half reel of three across the dance, starting left shoulder to second lady, while first man, with third couple, dance a half reel of three across the dance, starting left shoulder to third lady.

21-24 First lady casts up round second lady (third man's place) and dances across to finish in second place on own side facing in, while first man, following his partner, dances down and casts up to finish in second place on own side facing in.

25-26 Second and third couple cross over giving right hands, while 1st couple dance two pas de basque turning on the spot about 3 quarters to the right.

27-28 All three couples dance a quarter chase clockwise finish facing partner up and down the dance.

29-30 All three couples cross over with partner giving right hands.

31-32 All three couples dance a quarter chase clockwise back to own side.
