Stargazers

32 bar strathspey for 3 couples in a 3-couple set by Tim Wilson, 2009

- 1-6 1st couple **turn** with **both hands** once round, **dance down** between 3rd couple (nearer hands joined) and **cast up** to second place own side. 2nd couple step up on bars 5-6.
- 7-8 1st couple **turn** with **left hands** to face 2nd corners.
- 9-12 **Corners pass and turn**: 2nd corners **turn with right hands** in the center, 1st couple **pass each other by left** shoulders on bar 12 to face 1st corners.
- 13-16 **Corners pass and turn**: 1st corners **turn with right hands** in the center, 1st couple **pass each other by left** shoulders on bar 16 to face partner's 2nd corner (i.e. 1st woman faces 2nd woman, 1st man faces 3rd man).
- 17-18 1st couple **turn** partner's 2nd corner with **both hands** to finish in lines of three on the sides (order 2 1 3). **While** 1st corners **set** to one another on the diagonal.
- 19-22 All dance **back to back** with partner.
- 23-24 All set to the right and set advancing to the left to meet partner for:
- 25-32 Three-couple **allemande**.

Finish in order 3 1 2; new top couple ready to begin.
