## White Eagle

32 bar Jig for three couples in a four couple longwise set

## **Bars**

- 1 8 1st couple lead down the middle and up. Change sides, lady dancing under her partner's right arm, on bars 3 and 7. 1st couple finish in the middle of the set, 2nd couple step in.
- 9 16 1st and 2nd couples dance an Allemande, 1st couple finish facing first corners.
- 17 20 1st couple dance clockwise round first corner positions while first corners advance and retire. At the end 1st couple pass each other by the right shoulder to face second corners.
- 21 24 1st couple dance clockwise round second corner positions while second corners advance and retire. 1st couple finish in 2nd place on opposite sides.
- 25 32 1st couple dance reels of three across the dance, 1st couple giving left shoulder to partner's first corner to begin. On bars 31-32, 1st couple cross right hands while 2nd and 3rd couples curve into place.

Repeat, having passed a couple.
